Tasks

The scope was to find a general solution for logistics centers. The aim is to reduce the CO2 pollution caused by the energy supply of a warehouse center including logistics (truck traffic).

INP Services

- Elaboration of the energy supply based on renewable energies
- Preparation of a feasibility study for 100% green energy supply => CO2-free
- Pointing out the supply possibilities of renewable energies
- Economic feasibility study compared to the use of fossil fuels
- Calculated payback: just over 7 years without consideration of possible subsidies including H2 filling station
- Potential CO2 savings: over 22,000t/year
